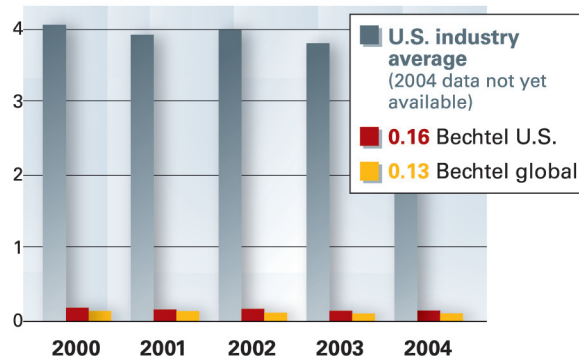

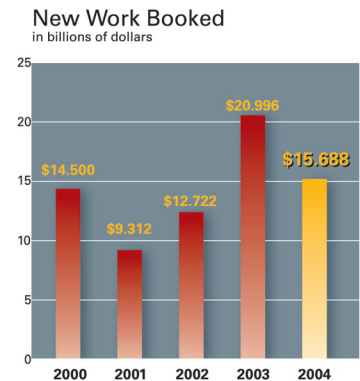
Safety on the job
