Christofer M. Mowry is the President of Babcock & Wilcox Nuclear Energy (B&W NE), a subsidiary of The Babcock & Wilcox Company (B&W). As President of B&W NE, Mr. Mowry is responsible for all commercial nuclear power business activities, including development and deployment of the B&W mPower™ reactor. He is also overseeing B&W NE's commercial manufacturing activities as well as nuclear construction and inspection services. Before joining B&W, Mr. Mowry served as President and Chief Operating Officer of Welding Services, Inc. (WSI) in Atlanta, Georgia from 2005-2008. Prior to this position, he held several high-level management positions with GE Energy. Mr. Mowry holds a Master of Science in Mechanical Engineering from Drexel University. He also earned a Bachelor of Science in Engineering and a Bachelor of Arts in Astronomy from Swarthmore College. He holds four U.S. patents related to digital control systems.



Jack Futcher

President of Bechtel Power

Jack Futcher is the president of Bechtel Power Corporation, responsible for managing Bechtel's global activities in development, execution, and services for fossil, nuclear, and renewable power. A 30-year veteran with Bechtel, Mr. Futcher has served in a variety of management, leadership, and operations roles throughout the company. Mr. Futcher led Bechtel's Global Procurement and Contracts Organization for six years, during which time the company purchased over \$30 billion dollars of equipment and materials. He also lived in Egypt and served as the project director of the \$1.4 billion Egypt LNG project. Prior to joining Bechtel Power as president, Mr. Futcher lived in London and was manager of downstream operations in Bechtel Oil, Gas and Chemicals, and was responsible for the global downstream business segment during a period of tremendous market sector growth. He is currently the chairman of the United States Energy Association and is on the Executive Committee and Board of Directors of the Nuclear Energy Institute. Mr. Futcher has a BS in finance from Lehigh University.
