Kimball is responsible for all of Bechtel's Infrastructure Americas profit and loss activities, marketing and business development, and overseeing design, construction, project management and delivery. From 2010 to 2015, Kimball led Bechtel's aviation and infrastructure business lines on a global basis where, as Managing Director, he held responsibility for all profit and loss aspects concerning the wide-ranging remits of infrastructure and aviation.

Prior to this, as President of Bechtel Construction Operations Incorporated from 2008 to 2010, he was in charge of functional and personnel administration, as well as having oversight of operations for Bechtel's global construction activities, including direct hire and construction management.

Other previous senior leadership roles include positions as General Manager of Infrastructure for Bechtel's Civil global business unit from 2007 to 2008 and, from 2004 to 2007, Manager of Construction for rail, aviation, infrastructure and building projects.

Prior to joining Bechtel in 1998, Kimball worked for the North American companies Atkinson PLC and Morrison-Knudsen.

Kimball earned his Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering from the University of Vermont. He was Vice President of the ASCE Construction Institute in 2003 and is a member of the European Construction Institute.
