Scott R. Johnson is General Manager of the Onshore Oil & Gas/Downstream Business Line for Bechtel Oil, Gas and Chemicals, Inc. He has served as project manager on a number of major projects to include the Saudi Aramco Ras Tanura Refinery Upgrade Project, and on the Karachaganak Development Project in Kazakhstan 2000, he became Petroleum and Chemicals (P&C) business line's manager of Engineering for EAMS (Europe, Africa, Middle East, and Southwest Asia). The following year, he became P&C's operations manager for EAMS, overseeing all P&C projects in the region. While in London he served as a Six Sigma champion and a member of London's Six Sigma oversight committee.



In 2003, Scott relocated to Houston to lead P&C's global engineering team, and he was elected a principal vice president. Later, he went to London, initially as project director for Abu Dhabi Gas Industries' OGD III project and then as project director for the Reliance Jamnagar Export Refinery Project in India. Scott returned to Houston in August 2008 to assume his current role, and was elected senior vice president.

A consummate technical professional who knows the downstream business from the ground up, Scott is viewed as a world-class project director. Hardworking and very capable, he has strong analytical skills, and his customer focus has helped deliver results on numerous projects. He has effective cross-cultural skills and is viewed as treating people fairly and respectfully.
