BIOGRAPHY

Steve Hawkins is general manager of the Pipeline business line for Bechtel Oil, Gas & Chemicals. He's led Pipeline since 2011.

Hawkins joined Bechtel in 2003 as general manager of the Bechtel and Enka joint venture providing TengizChevroil engineering and construction services to increase crude production and processing at Kazakhstan's Tengiz oil field. He later was Bechtel's project manager on the Egyptian LNG project and the Motiva oil refinery expansion project in Texas.

In 2006, Steve became assistant manager of operations for Bechtel Oil, Gas & Chemicals and, in 2009, he became senior project manager on the Keystone and Keystone Extension pipeline projects.



He was elected a principal vice president in 2014.

Hawkins came to Bechtel after more than 20 years serving the United States Marine Corps. He began in the early 1980s as a naval aviator and went on to gain experience in project controls, operations management, and other disciplines. He also served as executive assistant to the NATO commander in chief.

Hawkins holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in German from the University of Maryland, a Graduate Diploma in strategic leadership from the U.S. Army War College in Pennsylvania, a Master of Public Administration degree from Shippensburg University (also in Pennsylvania), and a Graduate Diploma in advanced management from Rice University in Texas.
