Confirmed or suspected COVID-19 case policy

Bechtel controlled construction work sites, offices, and facilities

Nothing in this guidance document is intended to circumvent or otherwise contradict requirements established by an Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ) within a country or region of operations.

Definitions:

- Symptoms Consistent with COVID-19: The U.S. CDC identifies the following symptoms of COVID-19:
 - » Cough
 - » Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - » Fever
 - » Chills

- » Muscle pain
- » Sore throat
- » New loss of taste or smell
- Gastrointestinal symptoms like nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
- Confirmed COVID-19 Case: A confirmed COVID-19 case is any person who has received a
 positive laboratory test result for COVID-19.
- Suspected COVID-19 Case: A suspected COVID-19 case is any person exhibiting any one of the symptoms consistent with COVID-19.

If an AHJ identifies additional symptoms, offices or projects may use the additional symptoms identified by the AHJ along with those identified above.

Bechtel Policy:

- Required Reporting: A failure to report as required below may result in disciplinary action, up to and including termination.
 - » Confirmed COVID-19 Cases: All employees are required to notify their supervisor or ES&H representative if they are a confirmed COVID-19 case. This ensures that Bechtel is able to identify employees who have been in close contact with the confirmed COVID-19 case pursuant to its Contact Tracing & Close Contact with Confirmed or Suspected COVID-19 Cases Policy.
 - Suspected COVID-19 Cases: All employees are required to notify their supervisor or ES&H representative if they are a suspected COVID-19 case. This ensures that Bechtel is able to identify employees who have been in close contact with the suspected COVID-19 case pursuant to its Contact Tracing & Close Contact with Confirmed or Suspected COVID-19 Cases Policy.
 - <u>Laboratory Test Results for COVID-19</u>: Suspected COVID-19 employees who
 are subsequently tested for COVID-19 are required to notify their supervisor,
 ES&H representative or HR representative of their test results, whether positive
 or negative, and provide documentation of a negative laboratory test result. This
 ensures that Bechtel is able to update the mitigation measures applicable to the



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suspected COVID-19 case and other employees who were in close contact with the suspected COVID-19 case pursuant to its Contact Tracing & Close Contact with Confirmed or Suspected COVID-19 Cases Policy. Documentation of the negative laboratory test result shall be provided to the appropriate HR representative for filing in the employee's parallel personnel file.

- Self-Quarantine & Return to Work Timing: All employees who are confirmed or suspected COVID-19 cases will be informed verbally of the mitigation measures applicable to them and when they will be permitted to return to work. After verbal notification and review, the employee shall be provided the completed Confirmed or Suspected COVID-19 Case Mitigation Measures Form and be required to acknowledge its receipt. See Annex 1 Confirmed or Suspected COVID-19 Case Mitigation Measures Form. The acknowledged Confirmed or Suspected COVID-19 Case Mitigation Measures Form shall be provided to the appropriate HR representative for filing in the employee's parallel personnel file. The applicable mitigation measures and return to work guidance is as follows:
 - Confirmed COVID-19 Cases: All employees who are confirmed COVID-19 cases shall self-quarantine for 14 days, and may return to work only after:
 - the 14-day self-quarantine period has elapsed; and
 - they are symptom free; and
 - they present a medical clearance to their supervisor, ES&H representative or HR representative.
 - » Suspected COVID-19 Cases:
 - Who Are Not Subsequently Tested for COVID-19: All employees who are suspected COVID-19 cases and are not subsequently tested for COVID-19 shall self-quarantine for 14 days, and may return to work only after:
 - the 14-day self-quarantine period has elapsed; and
 - they are symptom free.
 - Who Subsequently Test Positive for COVID-19: All employees who are suspected COVID-19 cases and subsequently test positive for COVID-19 shall self-quarantine for 14 days, and may return to work only after:
 - the 14-day self-quarantine period has elapsed; and
 - they are symptom free; and
 - they present a medical clearance to their supervisor, ES&H representative or HR representative.
 - Who Subsequently Test Negative for COVID-19: All employees who are suspected COVID-19 cases and subsequently test negative for COVID-19, may return to work immediately if:
 - they provide documentation of the negative laboratory test result to their supervisor, ES&H representative or HR representative; and
 - they are symptom free.
- Contact Tracing Interview: All employees who are confirmed or suspected COVID-19 cases are required to participate in a contact tracing interview pursuant to Bechtel's Contact Tracing & Close Contact with Confirmed or Suspected COVID-19 Cases Policy.

Notice to Suspected COVID-19 Cases Who Are Subsequently Tested for COVID-19	Suspected COVID-19 employees who are subsequently tested for COVID-19 are required to notify their supervisor, ES&H representative or HR representative of their test results whether positive or negative. All employees who are suspected COVID-19 cases and subsequently test positive for COVID-19 shall self-quarantine for 14 days, and may return to work only after: the 14-day self-quarantine period has elapsed; and they are symptom free; and they present a medical clearance to their supervisor, ES&H representative or HR representative. All employees who are suspected COVID-19 cases and subsequently test negative for COVID-19, may return to work immediately if: they provide documentation of the negative laboratory test result to their supervisor, ES&H representative or HR representative; and they are symptom free.
